The ANGA COM exhibition and conference has been moved to 8-10 June 2021 in Cologne, Germany.

ANGA COM

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ANGA COM is a leading European business platform for Broadband, Television and Online. It brings together network operators, vendors and content providers on all issues of broadband and media distribution.

Due to the coronavirus pandemic and corresponding requirements from the health authorities for major events, ANGA COM, scheduled for mid-May 2020, has now been postponed to **8-10 June 2021** in Cologne, Germany.

ANGA COM in 2018 attracted more than 500 exhibitors from 35 countries and 20,000 participants from 83 countries. Among the largest exhibitors were telecom vendors such as Appeer TV; AVM; Casa Systems; Cisco; CommScope; Nokia; Synamedia; Teleste and Wisi. The speaker line-up for the conference programme, with 2,400 participants, included

C-level representatives from Deutsche Telekom; Vodafone; Tele2; Sunrise; TDC; freenet; Eutelsat; ProSiebenSat.1; RTL Television and Discovery.

Around 540 network and platform operators participated in ANGA COM 2018, serving more than 200 million households all over Europe, as well as 370 media companies. Forty-four per cent of the participants were of a senior level. Key themes during ANGA COM included Gigabit Networks; FTTH; 5G; OTT; AppTV; Cloud TV; Video Streaming; Smart City and Smart Home.

With Vodafone, Deutsche Telekom, RTL and a large number of local fibre network operators, the Cologne area is a leading German business hub for broadband and media. Around forty-million people live within a radius of 250 kilometres. Three international airports (Cologne, Düsseldorf and Frankfurt) can be reached in less than an hour.

Dr. Dirk Wössner, Member of the Management Board for Germany, Deutsche Telekom, commented : "ANGA COM

has a fixed place in my calendar. Every year I look forward to exciting and informative days in Cologne: from the panel discussion and exhibition stands to the meetings with customers, colleagues and competitors. At ANGA COM, you can ‘touch’ digitalisation.”

Dr. Thomas Bellut, Chair, ZDF, added, “The intelligent, digital networking of content and distribution is a major priority for us at ZDF. ANGA COM offers an intelligent network. In the classic sense, you meet people – producers, experts, entrepreneurs – and discuss the opportunities, risks and feasibility of new technologies.”

Dr. Christian Franckenstein, CEO, Bavaria Film, said, “ANGA-COM, both as an exhibition and with its conference programme, offers an excellent forum for sustainable and future-oriented discussions between experts and managers from broadband, television, streaming and production. Together, we face the

challenge of mastering the disruption from the analogue to the digital world. I found the exchange with colleagues from different disciplines in the same industry extremely fruitful. I particularly like the international openness of the programme, its participants and visitors.”

Cooperation with the SCTE

ANGA COM has enjoyed successful and long-term cooperation with the SCTE™, The Society for Broadband Professionals. For many years, both organisations have developed a conference panel together. A special conference programme this year was planned, to celebrate the SCTE's 75th anniversary, at ANGA COM but this will now be postponed to 2021.

Mike Thornton, on behalf of the SCTE, also chaired a panel at the recent ANGA webinar on **17 November 2020**. The event highlighted what operators should consider today for both FTTX and DOCSIS.
